

Profiles of the Conceptual Plan Consultants and the Project Consultant

Foster + Partners Limited (appointed one of the Conceptual Plan Consultants)

Foster + Partners Ltd., an architectural practice led by Founder and Chairman Lord Foster, is based in London with project offices worldwide, including Hong Kong. Over the past four decades the practice has pioneered a sustainable approach to architecture and ecology through a wide range of work, from urban masterplans, public infrastructure, airports, civic and cultural buildings, offices and workplaces to private houses and product design. The studio has established an international reputation with buildings such as the world's largest airport terminal in Beijing, Swiss Re's London headquarters, Hearst headquarters in New York, Millau Viaduct in France, the German Parliament in the Reichstag, Berlin, The Great Court at London's British Museum, headquarters for HSBC in Hong Kong and London, and Commerzbank headquarters in Frankfurt. The practice also has a strong interest in city planning and infrastructure. It has received over 500 awards for excellence and won 92 national and international competitions since its inception in 1967.

Office for the Metropolitan Architecture (OMA) is an international partnership practicing contemporary architecture, urbanism and cultural analysis. Established in 1975 with offices in Rotterdam, New York, Beijing and Hong Kong, the company is led by six partners — Rem Koolhaas, Ole Scheeren, Ellen van Loon, Reinier de Graaf, Shohei Shigematsu and Managing Partner Victor van der Chijs.

OMA's recently completed projects include Prada Transformer, a rotating multi-use pavilion in Seoul, the Zeche Zollverein Historical Museum and master plan in Essen, and the Casa de Música in Porto. OMA is currently working on the company's largest project to date, the China Central Television (CCTV) headquarters, which is nearing completion. Recently, the company won a competition to build the new Taipei Performing Arts Centre in Taiwan.

The work of Rem Koolhaas and Ole Scheeren has won a number of international awards, including the Pritzker Architecture Prize, the Praemium Imperiale (Japan), the RIBA Gold Medal (UK) and the Mies van der Rohe-European Union Prize for Contemporary Architecture.
